### *Infant Activity*

Play hide-and-seek with the characters in your book. Invite your baby to choose a book and then sit together to read and look at the pictures. Pretend that you can not see a character.

Say "Where is the (duck)?" Encourage baby to point to the character, or point for them and say "There it is! We found you!"

### *Toddler Activity*

Snuggle with your child and tell them the story of the first day they came home.

Toddlers love to hear about when they were babies. You might mention things like how big they were when they were a baby compared to how big they are now. The kinds of things they did when they were very little, like sleep a lot during the day or not being able to eat snacks!

### *Preschool Activity*

"Chicka Chicka Boom Boom" by Bill Martin is one of the most beloved children's book of all time. You might want to read the book or check out a read-aloud on line. Use a cardboard paper towel tube and see if you can balance magnetic letters on top. Here comes "T" up the coconut tree! Can we balance "T" on top of "G"?
