



What Will My Child Learn?

MONDAY

Infant Activity

Create a book of family members. Use a photo of one family member per page and few group photos. Read with baby and name their loved ones. You might ask your older baby to point family members by name or flip the pages to find someone. Believe it or not, these are key pre-reading skills!

Toddler Activity

Act out a story while you create it together. Begin with “Once upon a time, there was a teeny, tiny egg” then pretend to curl your body up as if you are inside of an egg.

Ask your child “What do you think will hatch?” Maybe a duck? Then hop up and pretend to be a duckling! You can curl back up into your egg and pretend to hatch into a new animal.

Preschool Activity

Turn-taking story: Start telling a story and have your child (and other family members) take turns telling the next part of the story. For example:

Mommy: Once upon a time, there was a little boy...

Son: and he went to the farm to see chickens.

Daughter: The chickens were sleeping in the chicken house.

Mommy: So he decided to go somewhere else instead.

This is a great game for car rides or family dinner.
