



What Will My Child Learn?

## WEDNESDAY

### *Infant Activity*

Ask your child to read a book to you. Sign and say “book, please?” With a questioning expression. And point to a book. You might take turns reading the book to one another. Remember to say and sign “thank you!”

### *Toddler Activity*

Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Read the story together and then toy figures or stuffed animals to set up things in threes. We can host a pretend breakfast. We will need three chairs, three bowl, three spoons, etc. Help your child count 1, 2, 3 and assign an item to each toy.

### *Preschool Activity*

Take a reading drive or walk! There are lots of signs that children are able to “read” or recognize. (Things like the STOP sign, the grocery store sign or the Target logo!) Recognizing the meaning of print is a reading skill. Your child could also tell you the letters they spot or read some words that they know. (Example: I see M for Mama on the Market sign)
