Infant Activity

Pet a Dinosaur: Use a few different types of materials and cut them into a simple dinosaur shape, (can use a stencil too), then model for baby how you can touch and pet the dinosaur.

How does it feel? It is soft, smooth, bumpy, rough?

Some materials to consider: paper grocery bags, tinfoil, fabric, or corrugated cardboard. Be sure to keep baby from chewing off bits of material.

Toddler Activity

Dinosaur Sand Dig:

Let's pretend to be a paleontologist! Grab a bin and add some sand, paintbrushes and plastic dinosaurs and let your child dig and discover dinosaurs!

Preschool Activity

Did you know that dinosaurs couldn't live on earth anymore partially due to the increased volcanic activity?

Let's explore with volcano eruption sensory play: mix a water, a few drops of paint and baking soda together to make a slurry texture. Place in an ice cube tray or paper cup, then freeze. Once frozen, place on a plate for your child. Give them a little cup of vinegar and a spoon. Let the eruptions begin!
