Infant Activity

Create a salt-dough foot fossil! [Use the recipe linked here to create a quick, salty dough.](#) Feel free to add a bit of coloring or paint if you like. If your baby is mobile, talk to them about stomping feet, model how we stomp our feet on the ground. Try marching together by holding your baby and placing their feet atop your own while you stomp. Roll out a ball of the salt dough and then flatten a bit. Support baby and press their foot into the dough. Now you can keep a souvenir "stomp" for years to come!

Toddler Activity

Sing and march to the song. Encourage your child to act out the happenings in the song. Stop and eat some food, or take a rest in your nest before you march along again!

Preschool Activity
