## THURSDAY

### *Infant Activity*

#### T-Rex Hug!

With baby lying on the floor, kneel down beside them. Tell them you're going to give them a T-Rex hug! Lean down to them and give them a hug (keeping your arms tight to your own body is optional) Then sit up and count, 1...2...3! And lean down for a hug again! Repeat, emphasizing counting to three and building anticipation.

### *Toddler Activity*

Plant-eater VS Meat-eater dinosaur teeth. Dinosaurs with flat teeth eat plants. Dinosaurs with sharp teeth eat meat. Let's sort sharp teeth (triangles) and flat teeth (squares). Cut out several triangles and squares from white paper. mix them all up in a bowl. Invite your toddler to pull one out and decide if its a triangle tooth for a meat-eater or a square tooth for a plant-eater. You might add another shape, like a circle, which when pulled out means you have to do a little dance or give a dinosaur roar!

### *Preschool Activity*

#### Fossilized Dino Eggs:

1 cup flour, 1 cup used coffee grinds, 1/2 cup salt, 1/4 cup sand In large bowl, mix all the ingredients into a dough. Remove the dough and knead it on a floured surface. Hide small dinos in the center of the dough and allow to dry in a warm place for 2-3 days. When dry, the dough will look and feel like a rock. Break open the rock with a small hammer to reveal the hidden dinosaurs!
