Fall Sensory Bottles -Gather and place pinecones, leaves, acorns or other fall materials in a sensory bottle or empty clear drink bottle. For babies not yet reaching and grasping, these can be used to promote head turning or for visual exploration in Tummy Time

Standard: Respond to music by joining in on one or two words in a song or moving physically upon hearing a familiar melody or rhythm
