## MONDAY

### *Infant Activity*

Cloudy day mobile: Glue a few cotton balls to strings. Hang the strings off of the edge of a table. Invite baby to lay under the table and gaze at the clouds together. Talk about the kind of shapes that you see.

### *Toddler Activity*

Your child will love to repeat the vocalizations in this song!

### *Preschool Activity*

Rain can sometimes make a day feel gloomy. But rain is great for the plants and animals of the world. How do human's stay dry in the rain? Explore the idea of "waterproof" with your child. Use an eye-dropper or straw to collect small quantities of water and drip a few raindrops onto items to find out if they are waterproof or not. Collect items such as paper towel, a bit of fabric, a plastic bag, a rainboot, or a stuffed toy. What happens to the raindrops on each item? Is the item waterproof or absorbent?
