## THURSDAY

### *Infant Activity*

Explore the wind with your baby. Fold a paper fan and use it to gently fan air on baby's hair or bare feet. Talk to baby about the cool breeze. Say "whoosh goes the wind!"

### *Toddler Activity*

Let's play Lightning and Thunder! This is a game that teaches listening skills and patience. Whenever we see lightning, we will hear thunder shortly after. We cannot have thunder without lightning. Pretend that a flashlight is the lightning and a cookie sheet is the thunder. Model for your child first: Flash the light and say "Lightning! 1...2...3..." shake the cookie sheet and say "Thunder!" then repeat. Ask your toddler to play the role of thunder. When they see lightning, we count to three and then create thunder! Your child might want to take turn playing the role of lightning or thunder.

### *Preschool Activity*

Did you know that clouds are made of water droplets and a little bit of dust? We can make our own cloud at home! You will need a glass jar, hot water, ice cubes and a little bit of hairspray (or equivalent aerosol spray)
