



What Will My Child Learn?

Infant Activity

Puddle Splashing! Place a towel on the floor and place a cookie sheet on top. Add just a tiny bit of water to create a small puddle- not to fill the bottom of the cookie sheet. Show baby the puddle and encourage them to splash their hands or feet into it. Make sure to repeat words like: splash, wet, water, rain. This activity is great for tummy time under close supervision!

Toddler Activity

Let's pretend to be the wind! Blow bubbles for your toddler. They will want to chase, pop and catch them. But have they tried acting like the wind and blowing them away? Model blowing the bubbles high up into the sky. See how far you can send a bubbles blowing away in the breeze!

Preschool Activity

It Looked Like Spilled Milk: In this story, children imagine many different objects that are floating in the sky. But it's not spilled milk, it's clouds. We can use our imagination to see different pictures within the blobs of cloud. Use a bit of white paint and a folded piece of paper. Squish the paint between the folds of the paper, then open to reveal your cloud shape. Describe what you think it looks like. Encourage your child to tell a story about what their cloud shape is doing in the sky and where it will travel!
