Creative Expression

Standard: Focus attention on interesting sight or sounds, often in shared experiences with adults React to stimulation in the environment. This includes drawings, sculptures or painting

Sign Language

Standard: Remember language heard repeatedly in stories, poems, and interactive language experiences

Show Your Little Ones How Much You Love Them By Teaching Signs of Comfort Consider the importance of showing how to give and receive affection. Introduce signs such as hug, I love you and kiss.

Sensory

Standard: Focus attention on interesting sight or sounds, often in shared experiences with adults

Floating Catch - Get it! Gentle games of catch give babies a thrill – and help develop their hand/eye coordination. Gather some lightweight, colorful scarves and toss them in the air so that they float down in front of your baby and she can attempt to grab them. If you don't have scarves, you can use non-toxic bubbles in your game of catch

Music and Movement

Standard: Respond to music by joining in on one or two words in a song or moving physically upon hearing a familiar melody or rhythm

Math/Science/Writing

School around the world: Children are interested in learning more about children their own age, including what school looks like in other countries. Set up a “school” interest center in a portion of your home. Add photos, books, videos and other activities that feature students at school in another culture.

Encourage discussions about school in other countries by asking questions such as, “How do the children get to school?” and “What do they eat for lunch?” Rotate cultures throughout the year so students are exposed to many different school experiences from around the globe.

How it teaches diversity: By focusing on school, children can automatically relate to experiences of children around the world
